I am Full Professor at Faculdade de Economia do Porto (FEP), University of Porto, Portugal, a research fellow at CEF.UP and INESC TEC. I was a visiting scholar at the IC2, Texas Austin University (USA), Max Planck Institute of Economics - The Evolutionary Economics Group, Jena (Germany), and Innovation Studies Group (ISG), Politecnico di Torino (Italy). I hold a Ph.D. degree from SPRU - Science Policy Research Unit (University of Sussex, UK) and a masters and undergraduate degrees in Economics from University of Porto.

My research interests include economic growth, innovation, human capital, structural change, scientometrics, entrepreneurship, technology commercialization, U-I linkages, and academic ethics. I have published in journals such as *Applied Economics Letters*; *Cambridge Journal of Economics*; *European Planning Studies*; *Higher Education*; *Industrial and Corporate Change*; *Journal of Evolutionary Economics*; *Regional Studies*; *Research Policy*; *Review of Development Economics*; *Review of Managerial Science*; *Scientometrics*; *Structural Change and Economic Dynamics*; *World Economy*.
